

## Which are the main features of 2016 Vietnamese graduates?



- Mostly women
- Family background more educated than average values for foreign graduates in Italy (64% vs 39%), higher than values reported for Chinese and Asiatic graduates
- Average degree mark similar to Chinese one, higher than foreigners' average

Academic Performance:

- Average age at graduation (26,1 years) lower than average values for foreigners (27,5 years); average age similar to that reported for Chinese graduates
- Average degree mark higher (100,3) than that reported for all the other foreigners
- Vietnamese graduates significantly more regular in completing their studies «in course» than graduates coming from other countries

Average degree mark	100,3	94,3	97,3	97,6	102,7
Attendance: in course of study (%)	70,5	49,4	45,5	48,6	48,8

During academic studies:

- Vietnamese graduates experienced a part of their studies abroad (28%), more than other foreign graduates
- Vietnamese graduates undertook less traineeships than other foreign graduates (44% vs 55%)
- Less work experiences during their studies than other foreign graduates (53% vs 71%)
- Vietnamese graduates received significantly more scholarships (86%) than all the other foreign graduates

### Assessment of university experience:

- Vietnamese graduates are pretty satisfied with their university experience (97% vs 90% for other foreign graduates)
- 64% of Vietnamese graduates would enroll again in the same course of study at the same university; similar value as Chinese one, slightly lower than the average value for foreign graduates

- **Conclusions**

- From 2004 to 2016 the **number of Vietnamese graduates enrolled** at Italian universities **increased**: 3 in 2004 and 61 in 2016
- Main features of **Vietnamese graduates in Italy in 2016**:
  - Come from educated families
  - Had a brilliant path at secondary school level
  - Brilliant academic performances both as degree mark and study attendance are concerned
  - Experienced part of their studies abroad
  - Received scholarships
  - Did not work during university studies
  - Are really satisfied with their university experience
- The **number of Vietnamese graduates enrolled** at Italian universities **is increasing** also thanks to the **agreements** concluded over time **between Vietnamese and Italian universities**
- Despite the fact that **Vietnamese graduates** are currently **few in number**, further progress can be made and we are confident that **Italy will become an attractive destination** for young Vietnamese in the next future
