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What a cluster is

The definition of clusters:

Traditionally, we talk about clusters when a large number of businesses operating in the same sector (or in correlated ones) are grouped in relatively small areas;

The large majority of these businesses are small-sized (less than 10 employees);

So they (were used to) generate monocultural areas in which every company has a low level of vertical integration;





Our experience

The development of this organization dates back to 1960s and 1970s and is due to:

- The development of trade union power since 1960s → their power is limited to those firms with more than 15 employees: a twofold labor market;
- 2) The reduction of the importance of economies of scale in favor of the importance of customization (short series of production) + the increasing importance of flexibility + the importance of agglomeration economies (for innovation, incremental in specific – Marshallian economies) + the importance of knowledge that can't be codified;
- The cultural environment: "it's better to be the head of a little undercapitalized company than a manager of a multinational". This was the prevailing mood those days;
